It is a sequence of events, situation, or conflict that must be resolved, causes tension among characters. It is plausible/credible.



□ They may be **round**, **stock**, **flat**.

The audience care about them They are believable for the audience.



1. It is main idea/point of a drama.

2. It is significant for a story of a drama.

(4) **SETTING**:

It is related to time & place of a story with buildings or backgrounds. It reinforce plot, characters and theme.
